# Cocamide Diethanolamine (Cocamide DEA) (Coconut Oil Diethanolamine Condensate)

# Why am I being warned about potential exposure to cocamide DEA?



- Cocamide DEA is on the <u>Proposition 65</u> list because it can cause cancer. Exposure to cocamide DEA may increase the risk of cancer.
- Proposition 65 requires businesses to determine if they must provide a warning about significant exposure to <u>listed chemicals</u>.

#### What is cocamide DEA?

- Cocamide DEA is a colorless liquid used in cosmetics and personal care products such as bath oil, shampoo, conditioner, and hair dye. It is also used in some pet-care and household-cleaning products.
- The use of cocamide DEA has decreased in recent years.

# How does exposure to cocamide DEA occur?

 Exposure to cocamide DEA may occur by skin contact with products that contain the chemical.

# How can I reduce my exposure to cocamide DEA?

✓ Read the product labels on cosmetics, personal care products, pet-care products and household cleaning products, and choose those without cocamide DEA.
