
Why am I being warned about potential exposure to PCBTF?

- PCBTF is on the <u>Proposition 65</u> list because it can cause cancer. Exposure to PCBTF may increase the risk of cancer.
- Proposition 65 requires businesses to determine if they must provide a warning about significant exposure to <u>listed chemicals</u>.

What is PCBTF?

PCBTF is a solvent used in some caulks, paints and coatings. It is also found in some fabric stain removers.

How does exposure to PCBTF occur?



• During pregnancy, PCBTF can pass from mother to baby.

How can I reduce my exposure to PCBTF?

When using products that may contain PCBTF, always follow the manufacturer's instructions and safety precautions on the product label. Ventilate your workplace well.
